

FINAL LIST OF CANDIDATES FOR ELECTION OF EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE
PAKISTAN SOLAR ASSOCIATION – TERM 2026–2028

Pursuant to Rule 18(14) of the Trade Organizations Rules, 2013, as amended from time to time, and in accordance with the duly approved Election Schedule of Pakistan Solar Association for the term 2026 – 2028, the **Final List of Candidates for election to the Executive Committee** is hereby issued and displayed.

The nomination papers received within the prescribed period were scrutinised by the Election Commission on 27 August 2026 in accordance with Rule 18(11), following which the list of candidates found eligible was duly issued and displayed.

The Election Commission further records that **no objection whatsoever against any candidate appearing in the list of accepted nominations was received by the Election Commission within the prescribed period, either at the registered office/address of Pakistan Solar Association or through the official email channels of the Association.**

Consequently, no determination on an objection was required from the Election Commission under Rule 18(12), and, on the record presently available before the Election Commission, no subsequent order or direction has been received requiring alteration of the accepted candidates listed herein from the DGTO.

Accordingly, upon completion of the prescribed nomination, scrutiny and objection stages, the candidates appearing in **Annexure-A** are hereby confirmed as the **Final Candidates for election to the Executive Committee of Pakistan Solar Association for the term 2026 – 2028.**

The Election Commission has observed that the approved composition presently provides for **twelve (12) Executive Committee seats**, whereas, upon completion of scrutiny and the objection period, **exactly twelve (12) candidates have been found acceptable and presently constitute the Final List of Candidates.**

Accordingly, there is prima facie no numerical contest between the available seats and the number of validly nominated candidates. Conducting a poll in such circumstances may not alter the composition of the Executive Committee, irrespective of the number of votes cast in favour of the respective candidates.

However, since the approved Election Schedule presently provides for polling on **14 September 2026**, and Rule 18(15) of the Trade Organizations Rules, 2013 contains a specific provision regarding polling following issuance of the Final List of Candidates, the Election Commission considers it appropriate that the matter be determined on a clear legal footing before any scheduled electoral stage is dispensed with or modified in case of which the corrigendum to the election schedule shall be issued.

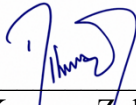
The Secretary General is hereby required to place the foregoing position before PSA's Legal Counsel forthwith and obtain a written legal opinion on the following questions:

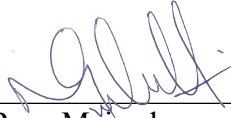
1. Whether, where the number of validly nominated candidates is exactly equal to the number of available Executive Committee seats, all such candidates may lawfully be **declared elected unopposed**, without conducting a physical poll or secret ballot;
2. Whether Rule 18(15) of the Trade Organizations Rules, 2013 nevertheless requires polling to be conducted in such circumstances, notwithstanding that the outcome and composition of the Executive Committee cannot mathematically change through polling;
3. In the event that the twelve candidates may lawfully be declared elected unopposed, what shall constitute the legally effective **date of election of the Executive Committee** for the purposes of Rule 18(16) and the commencement of the subsequent office-bearer nomination process;
4. Whether the remaining Election Schedule may consequently be **amended, shortened, rationalised or re-notified**, particularly in respect of those stages and timelines which become redundant in the absence of a contested Executive Committee poll;
5. Whether such amendment or modification may lawfully be approved internally by the competent body of PSA and notified through a corrigendum, or whether **prior approval, confirmation or specific direction of the Regulator / DGTO** is required before departing from the Election Schedule already approved, displayed and submitted to the Regulator; and
6. What consequential amendments, if any, should be made to the dates for nomination and election of Office Bearers and the subsequent AGM / final-result announcement, while ensuring strict compliance with the statutory outer limit applicable to the election process.

Keeping the above position in view, the **Secretary General shall communicate the written legal position to the Election Commission positively within two (2) days of issuance of this Notice**, together with confirmation of any advice obtained from or reference considered necessary to be made to the Regulator / DGTO.

Until such legal clarification is received, the Election Commission shall continue to preserve the approved Election Schedule and election record, and no scheduled stage shall be treated as cancelled, dispensed with or amended merely by implication.

This Notice together with Annexure-A shall be displayed on the notice board of Pakistan Solar Association and circulated through the Association's official communication channels for information of all members and concerned parties.
